

CHISAGO COUNTY ADOPT-A-DRAIN



In 2022, Chisago County officially joined the Adopt-a-Drain program (through funding provided by the Chisago Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) and assistance by the Lower St. Croix Partnership)! Adopt-a-Drain is a program sponsored by Hamline University for residents to sponsor a storm drain located in their neighborhood.

Residents help prevent storm drain debris, including litter, leaves, grass clippings, and dirt, from going into local lakes and rivers. Residents clean the drain regularly, track the maintenance and the amount of debris they remove from the drain, and inspire other neighbors to adopt and maintain storm drains.

In 2022, Chisago County residents adopted 59 drains through the Adopt-a-Drain program! Residents prevented approximately 80 lbs. of debris from going into our local lakes and rivers.
