

NORTH CENTER NORTH LINDSTROM CHANNEL RESTORATION FEASIBILITY TASK FORCE



The Chisago County Board of Commissioners has established a Task Force with the purpose of reviewing possible options for re-establishing a navigable channel between North Center Lake and North Lindstrom Lake.

The Task Force reviewed multiple channel design options. With each option the possible effects on wetlands, lake levels, and water quality were considered.

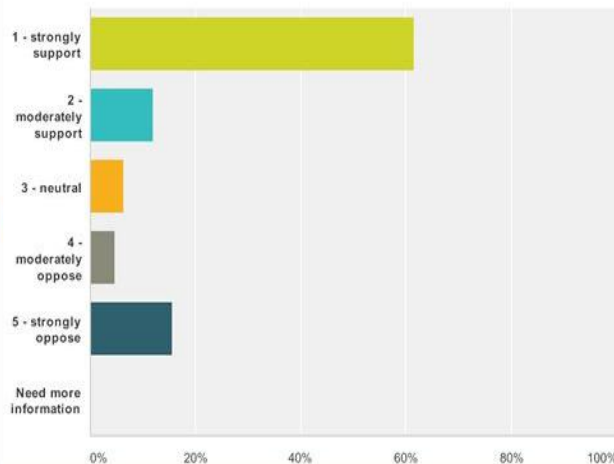
The Task Force recommended proceeding with the feasibility study on the removable weir option for restoring navigation between North Center and North Lindstrom Lakes.

As part of the process the Task Force conducted surveys to help determine public support or opposition to the proposed project. Over 500 people responded to the surveys. An example of survey results is provided below.

- Results generally showed strong community support for improved navigation
- For those opposed, some concerns included increased boat traffic & water level impacts to North Center
