

# BMP MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

The Chisago Soil & Water Conservation District partnered with the Chisago Lakes Lake Improvement District, Chisago County, Chisago Lakes School District, the City of Lindström, and the City of Chisago City to work on maintaining some of the publically owned best management practices in the area. The SWCD hired two staff people to work 15-25 hours total per week depending on the season.

- 378 hours were logged by the SWCD Maintenance Staff in 2016
- 1120 Conservation Corp hours
- 24.5 cubic yards of mulch (that's 2.5 big dump trucks full)
- 8,500 pounds of sediment removed from pretreatment chambers
- 445 native plants planted
- Countless loads of weeds removed
