

AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES EDUCATION



In 2016, Staff developed an Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Communication and Education Plan to educate citizens about AIS and encourage behavior that reduces or stops the spread of AIS in Chisago County. Educational activities for 2016 included developing an AIS handout, displaying the Stop Aquatic Hitchhiker banners at community festivals, presenting a session on Aquatic Plants at the Children’s Water Festival, submitting AIS articles in the Chisago County Environmental Connections newsletter and updating the Help Stop Aquatic Hitchhikers! signs located at public water accesses in Chisago County.
